- Discussed the proposed amendment to the Special Use Permits.
- Discussed the Comprehensive Plan and the process for final approval.
- Discussed the proposed Rigby Project. Director of Code Enforcement West stated the owner is interested in rebuilding with a laundry mat and a Cash Check-In Bank on the bottom floor with apartments above.
- Reviewed the approval process of a Concept Plan, a Preliminary Site Plan, and a Final Site Plan.
