

TOWN OF LAUREL
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

The Laurel General Municipal Election will be held on Thursday, March 23, 2023 from 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., in the Meeting Room of the Laurel Fire Hall located at 205 Tenth Street (Front Entrance). Registered voters must show proof of identification. There is a contest for the seat of Mayor between John Shwed and Mark Sikora. Registered voters of Ward One, Ward Two, Ward Three, and Ward Four (All Wards) are eligible to vote. The following uncontested candidates are: Carlos Oliveras, Council Ward One, Cheryl Martin, Council Ward 4, and Phillip C. Calio, Councilman At Large.

Any registered voter of the Town of Laurel, who wishes to vote by absentee voting, may do so by obtaining an “Affidavit for Absentee Voting” at the Town Office. Once the completed Affidavit is received by the Town, an official absentee ballot can either be mailed or picked up at the Town Office. Request for an absentee ballot shall be made by no later than noon on March 14, 2023. Completed absentee ballots are to be returned to the Town Manager no later than noon Wednesday, March 22, 2023.
